About the Exhibition:

between June 1 and August 30, 2024, and will accept entries on a rolling basis throughout the duration. The goal is to create an immersive display of artistic interpretations of places and experiences that celebrate travel, discovery, reflection, and observation.

Who can apply:

Any and all artists living and/or working in the United States are encouraged to apply. A limit of 5 entries per artist will be accepted. Entrants can request up to 5 blank postcards made from watercolor paper to use as a template or blank canvas for their submissions, though all media is accepted and does not have to be watercolor. All submitted work will be displayed!

About the venue:

10 Fold Projects opened its doors on Valentine's Day 2022 to celebrate our creative talent within Indiana and the Midwest. Since opening, 10 Fold Projects has regularly hosted monthly critique nights, exhibitions of regional artists such as Bobbi Meier from Chicago, IL, and local artists living in Greencastle, IN. We also partnered with IU Bloomington to exhibit work created by residents of Putnamville Correctional Facility. We continue to develop programming that brings communities together through art via exhibitions, workshops, and artist residencies.

Deadline:

Entries will be accepted on a rolling basis beginning June 1, 2024, through August 30, 2024. Entries received prior to August 15, 2024, will be displayed and on view at 10 Fold Projects, 10 W. Washington, Greencastle, IN.

Shipping:

Artists are responsible for shipping their work to and from the exhibition venue. Work can be mailed as a functional postcard via correct postage (please refer to your local USPS location or website for exact information). 10 Fold Projects will return all work within 30 days after the exhibition closes via USPS at no additional charge to the artist.

Events:

An artist reception will take place Saturday, August 10, 2024, from 5-7 pm.

How to Apply:
