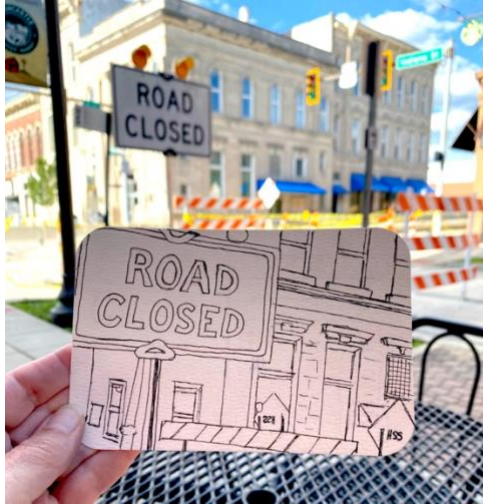


SHARE YOUR SUMMER WITH US!

Who can participate?

ANYONE! Open to all ages of creative individuals.

How do I get a postcard? Can I use any type of material?

Participants can pick up a blank postcard at Greencastle Arts Council's table at First Friday events. Blank postcards will also be available at various locations/events around Greencastle. Participants can also make their own card as long as it is not larger than 4 in by 6 in.

When will the postcards be displayed?

Postcards will be on display beginning July 13 and on view until the close of the exhibition, Saturday, August 31, 2024. Participants can submit postcards at any time between **June 15 and August 25, 2025**.

Is there a public reception for viewers to see the submitted postcards?

YES! 10 Fold Projects Gallery will host a public reception on **Saturday, August 31, 2024 between 5-7 pm**. Anyone interested in seeing unique handmade postcards are invited to stop by.

Will I get my postcard(s) back?

Yes. Participants can include their return address on the back of the postcard and they will be mailed via USPS one week after the exhibition concludes.
