## Hoosier Love (Who Is Your Love)

### About the Exhibition:

10 Fold Projects invites artists to submit works of art that are no larger than 12" in any direction that represents what you love and how you love what you do about Indiana. The exhibit is not only a play on words associated with our unique nickname, but it also encourages artists to consider what they love most about the Crossroads of America. The theme could also be interpreted to consider non-traditional ways of living a life filled with love, how we love one another, and who we love.

### Who can apply:

Any and all artists living and/or working in Indiana are encouraged to apply. All media accepted.

### About the venue:

10 Fold Projects opened its doors on Valentine's Day 2022 to celebrate our creative talent within Indiana and the Midwest. Since opening, 10 Fold Projects has regularly hosted monthly critique nights, exhibitions of regional artists such as Bobbi Meier from Chicago, IL, and local artists living in Greencastle, IN. We also partnered with IU Bloomington to exhibit work created by residents of Putnamville Correctional Facility. We continue to develop programming that brings communities together through art via exhibitions, workshops, and artist residencies.

### Deadline:

The deadline to enter the exhibit is **February 3, 2024**, and the exhibit runs from **February 18 to March 23, 2024**, at 10 Fold Projects, 10 W. Washington, Greencastle, IN.

### Juror:

Maggie Leininger, artist and independent curator, lives in the Chicago area and teaches drawing at DePaul University. Previous accomplishments include working with Judy Chicago and Suzanne Lacy to coordinate programming associated with an exhibition that Leininger designed featuring the *International Honor Quilt*, a companion project of *The Dinner Party* by Judy Chicago. Other curatorial accomplishments include a recent exhibition *Present: Not Present*, featuring artists working with imprisoned populations, migrant detainees, and inner-city youth. Leininger will select a diverse array of artists working across a variety of media to showcase expansive methods in which artists work.

### Shipping:

Artists are responsible for shipping their work to and from the exhibition venue. Accepted work will need to be either dropped off in person on **Saturday, February 17 between 10 am and 3 pm** or shipped to location by **Thursday, February 15**. Artists can pick up their work on **Sunday, March 24 between 9 am-Noon**. All remaining work will be shipped the week of **March 25<sup>th</sup>**.

### Events:

An opening reception will take place **Saturday, February 17 from 6-8 pm**.

### How to Apply:
